PROJECT DESCRIPTION / SUMMARY

This project is a sequel from the last project From Naga to the Earth 2010. The project will focus on traditional houses. Students have to find the 'messages' from the ancestor/builder by learning their local/traditional/ethnic houses. They can learn from its concept/philosophy, historical story, architecture, function of design, building material, interior, colour, pattern, etc. They will find out if many traditional houses used natural material for environment friendly style purpose. After the research, they will make reports with their ideas and creativities, with any kind of media, and then, compare with the others, and publish it.

Furthermore, the schools will be encouraged to create an event, where the students can share with the others all about the 'messages' from their relevant local/ traditional/ethnic houses, as well as the results to the other schools in Asia and Europe.

Finally it will be published through the website where each schools will share their own 'messages' from their local houses in Asia and Europe.

RATIONALE FOR THE PROJECT:

We want to introduce the students to the idea that the messages from the ancestors/builder through its traditional houses have so many important things for students as a youth generation. The objectives:

1. Students will understand about the philosophy of many kind of local/traditional houses in Asia and Europe
2. Preserve and take care of our traditional houses
3. Strengthen the students' value and character based on their local/traditional houses
4. The students develop an environment friendly style from their local/traditional houses
5. Develop the students' writing, reading, research, and communication skills

EXPECTED CONTRIBUTION FROM ASIAN SCHOOLS/STUDENTS:

Get involved and become a part of the project by :

1. Explore their own local/traditional house based on the criteria to find the message from the builder/ancestor
2. Analysis the concept, basic philosophy, and materials of the local/traditional house and related it to an environment friendly style
3. Find out what kind of value/character from the builder/ancestor through the local/traditional house
4. Report their research by make some product (based on their capabilities)
5. Share and publish it through website
