The Green Volunteers

PROJECT DESCRIPTION / SUMMARY

This project aims to promote VOLUNTEERISM among young students through students exchange programme. Students are encouraged to do at least 20 hours of voluntary work (January - March 2013) in their respective school/community, get a letter of recommendation from the authority concerned, send a report (with pictures/videos) to their teachers before 15 March 2013. Teachers or students from participating schools will send their reports via email to the project coordinator and also post the reports on the common Facebook site, to be shared among the participants

Teachers from participating schools will choose 3 - 5 students to be eligible for a 2-week Students Exchange Programme in May. Airfare will be borne by the students or their sponsors, the host country will arrange foster families for the students and also arrange for them to do voluntary work in the community for at least 20 hours. The number of students sent overseas by a school should

equal the number of foster families willing to accept foreign students. All students/teachers from participating schools must send their reports to the coordinator before 15 June 2013 to be edited and compiled. Periodical reports supported by pictures/videos will be posted on a common FB site and also emailed to the coordinator before 15 June 2013.

RATIONALE FOR THE PROJECT:

Volunteerism is an underutilised secret weapon that can bring an individual to a greater height socially, spiritually and mentally. It should be inculcated from young. Learning should not be confined to the four walls, it's time we break the walls and transform our students into socially responsible and caring individuals who are brave, independent and equipped with fine leadership qualities.

The use of ICT tools including digital camera, video camera, power point presentation, Facebook, email, twitter etc. will definitely give students a vast exposure to all the latest technologies and narrow or diminish the distance between two continents, thus achieve the objective of AEC-NET: "2 Continents, 1 Classroom".

All participating schools/students will take part in meaningful voluntary work to bring about improvement in the local and foreign environment/community. Students share their experiences with their friends from AEC-NET.
