## Activity 1: Parent-Teacher Collaboration “Better Together – Parents & Teachers”

### Background

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic caused severe disruptions in the education sector and heavily affected teachers, students and parents alike. School closures and the move to full home-based learning globally had far-reaching effects on the teaching & learning environment, ranging from challenges linked to curriculum development & delivery, access to technology to the lack of social engagement, etc.

This activity engages teachers and representatives from parents associations/committees from selected Asian & European schools. It focuses on the relationship between parents and teachers, which is crucial to help students flourish and to influence the students' learning progress, confidence and wellbeing at school. Participants will form teams to collaborate in a methodical manner: discussing strategies, planning activities and completing specific tasks to monitor the growth and holistic development of their children/students.

### Expected Outcomes

- The activity will create awareness on the importance of teacher-parent collaboration and encourages both parties to recognise and respect their unique roles in a student's learning process – in school and at home.
- This peer-to-peer exchange will be a platform for teachers & parents to learn about effective and assertive communication techniques to establish a cooperative and collaborative environment based on mutual trust.

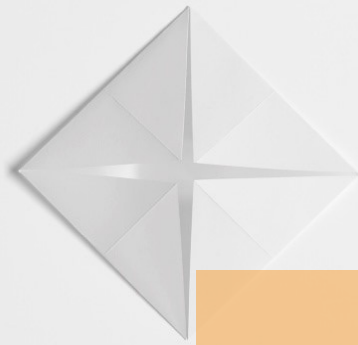
